### Speakers

#### Dr. John Abbondanza, OD

has been practicing behavioral optometry for over twenty years. He is in private practice at Vision Care Specialists in Southboro with a specialization in vision related learning problems and vision therapy. He lectures nationally and internationally on vision therapy related topics. He graduated from the NECO, and is Adjunct Clinical Professor of Optometry at SCO, NECO, and MCPHSCO. He is board certified in vision therapy and vision development by the COVD and is a past President of the Massachusetts Society of Optometrists. He currently is currently a supervisor of a residency in pediatrics/VT, an instructor for the OEP Clinical Curriculum, and Secretary/Treasurer of the OEP.

#### Dr. Robert A Hohendorf, OD

(Bob) is a 1975 graduate of Illinois College of Optometry. He was in a full scope private practice until January of 2004. He started a multidisciplinary clinic with an occupational therapist, an educational diagnostician, a speech, and language staff. He oversaw the vision therapy portion of the clinic. The clinic offered AIT, Somonas, Berard listening therapies, Sensory Integration, Interactive Metronome and cranio-sacral and visual therapies. It was sold and he became a part time employee until his clinical retirement in January of 2016.

He was recently (Jan 2013) asked to consult and examine acquired brain injury patients at the largest West MI hospital (Spectrum Health System) in their acute rehabilitation unit. He also retired from their in July of 2016.

Bob has been a team consultant to the local semi-pro basketball team. He has consulted with schools in the Western MI area for over 25 years. He has been the State director for the Optometric Extension Program (OEPF) since 1984. He currently serves as the chair of the OEPF education committee, and is one of 5 clinical care instructors. He enjoys his role as a case consultant. He has lectured extensively internationally.
