Speakers

Steve Gallop, OD has had extensive experience with vision therapy, as a patient, a doctor and as a therapist. Steve was his own first patient, managing to reduce his own nearsightedness. He has presented lectures at three ICBO meetings and was twice the keynote speaker at the European Kraskin Invitational Skeffington Symposium on Vision in Denmark. His articles on the philosophy and practice of developmental vision care have been published in several professional journals and books. His titles include "The Tao of Vision Training," "Compensating & Therapeutic Lenses: Passive vs. Dynamic Prescribing," and "Adventures in Lenses."

Dr. Gallop has a practice solely dedicated to providing evaluations and vision therapy for those with developmental differences, acquired brain injuries, vision related learning problems and myopia control/reduction. He does all therapy personally.

Valerie Frazer, OD graduated from Southern Illinois University with a BA in Physiology. She received her doctoral degree from Southern College of Optometry and is a Fellow of the College for Optometrists of Vision Development. Dr. Frazer's practice specializes in Optometric Vision Therapy and Neuro-Optometric Rehabilitation. She has lectured on the topics of vision and learning, therapeutic lens prescribing, primitive reflexes, vision development, strabismus, traumatic brain injury and visual dysfunctions in autism spectrum disorders. She is a member of the Waunakee Lions, Wisconsin Optometric Association, College of Optometrists for Vision Development, Optometric Extension Program and Neuro-Optometric Rehabilitation Association. She currently serves on the board of the Vision Leads Foundation and Great Lakes Optometric Congress.

Dr. Brandon Begotka, OD has been in practice at The Vision Therapy Center in Brookfield, WI since 2009. He earned a B.A. in Chemistry from Carthage College in Kenosha, WI and graduated with honors from the Illinois College of Optometry. He is a member of the American Optometric Association, Wisconsin Optometric Association, Optometric Extension Program Foundation, and College of Optometrists in Vision Development. He serves on the Board of Directors for the Vision Leads Foundation and the OEPF Great Lakes Congress. He was named the 2012 Young Optometrist of the Year by the Wisconsin Optometric Association and successfully completed a fellowship with the College of Optometrists in Vision Development in 2013.
