## LOOKING AT VISION DEVELOPMENT AND SPORTS PERFORMANCE

If you consider part of the definition for vision, "to guide movements," you can understand the role vision plays in athletics. This RCS is designed to give the optometrist a deeper understanding for how one can assess the state of visual development of the athlete, as it pertains to sports. The seminar is interactive. The testing sequence will be demonstrated. Attendees will have the opportunity to get up and play with different tests to get a feel for them. Material covered will include:

- A testing protocol for both teams and individuals
- Rationale behind the protocol
- Behavioral insights one can make during the testing sequence
- Examples of low-tech VT activities for the athlete
- Concussions and Sports

This two-day seminar will also touch on ideas for "portable" vision therapy for the athlete, as well as the optometrist's role involving concussions in athletics.

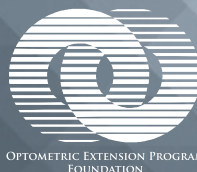
