Dr. Hohendorf is a graduate of Illinois College of Optometry where he participated in an intensified vision therapy internship under the tutelage of Dr.'s Coleman Hatfield and Leo Manas. He practiced in Grand Rapids, MI, in a full scope practice until 2003 when he moved to Wyoming, MI, and established a vision therapy referral practice within the multi-specialty clinic, The Vision and Sensory Center.

He has been a consultant to several local schools and the local professional basketball team, Grand Rapids Hoops.

His current activities include local, statewide, and international speaking on vision and learning. He is an instructor for the Optometric Extension Program Foundation's Clinical Curriculum courses. He is state director of the Michigan, Chair of the OEPF's Curriculum Development Committee, an associate member of COVD, OEPF, CSO, NORA, Michigan Optometric Association and American Optometric Association.

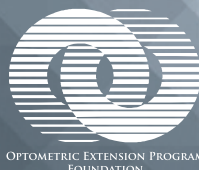
