#### Susan Daniel, OD

Susan Daniel has been in private practice with her husband, Dr. Christopher Davis, in Carlsbad, California since 1992. She obtained her Bachelor of Science degree from the University of California at Davis in 1987 and her Doctor of Optometry degree at the Southern California College of Optometry in 1991. She was on the clinical staff at the Southern California College of Optometry in Family Practice and Pediatric Service before opening her practice in Carlsbad. She offers comprehensive examinations for adults and children, contact lenses, laser surgery consultations, treatment of ocular disease, visual

efficiency and visual perceptual examinations, and vision rehabilitation therapy. She has hospital privileges at Tri-City Medical Center Acute Rehabilitation Services in the visual rehabilitation treatment for brain-injured patients and stroke victims. She has a special interest in serving children and adults with disabilities and is a consultant for the North Coastal Consortium for Special Education. She specializes in the visual development for children with autism and is the parent of an autistic child. She is a member of the American Optometric Association, College of Optometry Vision Development, National Optometric Rehabilitation Association, and Soroptimist International of Oceanside.

### Camilla Dukes, OD

Camilla Dukes is board certified in vision therapy and a Fellow of the College of Optometry in Vision Development. As a practicing developmental optometrist in Denmark, she specialized in providing vision therapy to patients with strabismus, amblyopia, visual efficiency and visual-motor perceptual problems, learning disabilities, stroke and traumatic brain-injury. She joined the practice of Drs. Daniel and Davis in June 2000, and lends her expertise in visual rehabilitation to this population. After returning to optometry school at Pacific University in Oregon, she received her United States Doctorate of Optometry in 2004. She is contracted with the school districts to provide visual development therapy to children with special needs and she does numerous lectures and in-services to doctors, therapists and teachers. Dr. Dukes is married with three children and is very involved with their activities.

### Earl L Smith III, OD, PhD, FAAO

Earl L. Smith III received his Doctor of Optometry and PhD from the University of Houston in 1972 and 1978 respectively, and joined the faculty at the University of Houston College of Optometry in 1978. He is currently the Dean of the University of Houston College of Optometry and was selected to be the Greeman-Petty Distinguished Professor in Vision Development in 1988. His primary research interests are centered on the effects of normal and abnormal visual experience on the developing visual system.

### Janice Wensveen, OD, PhD

Janice Wensveen, OD, PhD, received her Doctor of Optometry degree from the University of Waterloo School of Optometry, and her PhD from the University of Houston College of Optometry. She is currently a Clinical Associate Professor at UHCO where she teaches clinical binocular vision. Her research interests center on abnormal development of binocular vision, anisometropia, strabismus and amblyopia.

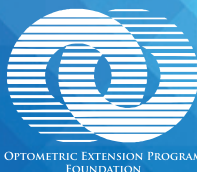
